Buenas yan Hafa Adai! Effective November 5, 2011, the FY2012 Government Fuel Contract No. GSA-118-11 was awarded to IP&E Holdings LLC dba: IP&E Guam, the licensee for Shell products and petroleum.

Unfortunately, due to the withdrawal of South Pacific Petroleum Corporation (SPPC/76) from the current Government Fuel Contract number GSA-118-11, SPPC / 76 is no longer a diesel fuel provider for the Location areas for the bus satellite requirements. Therefore all gas cards issued under the previous Government Fuel Contract No. GSA-082-06 are null and void, and must be surrendered to the General Services Agency via formal departmental memorandum for disposition.

Please be advised that IP&E Guam (Shell Service Stations) does not meet the location requirement for the Yona, Agat, and Inarajan Bus Satellites.

All departments and agencies that are participating under the current fiscal year 2012 Government Fuel Contract number GSA-118-11, may continue to use their existing and active Shell Gas Cards at any of the twelve Shell Service Stations island-wide.
