GENERALS:

These specifications have been written to describe minimum equipment and performance requirements to be supplied by the equipment manufacturer bidding. Reasonable test may be conducted upon delivery before acceptance.

The successful bidder shall furnish all necessary and desirable information instructions for the proper operation of the equipment.

The government reserves the right to accept and/or reject any and all bids, to waive any defects, irregularities, or specification discrepancies and to award the bid as council deems to be in the best interest of the government.

Each Reach Truck shall be new / unused, current model year or later production. Each Reach truck delivered shall comply with all applicable federal and local regulations\standards for equipment in its class.

Each Reach truck shall be supplied with all standard equipment and accessories indicated in manufacturer's published literature/brochure unless specifically deleted as stated in this specification. Optional equipment necessary to meet the requirements of this specification shall be installed.

Drive:

Electric with AC control.

Rated Capacity:

3,300 lbs. Minimum. Maximum lift capacity at fork height shall be no less 1,000 lbs.

Mast:

Triple Stage. Max fork height – 190 inches minimum.
Collapsed mast height - 87 inches minimum.

Carriage:

The carriage shall be single reach with tilt and fork side-shift features. The open end clearance of base arms shall be no more than 48 inches wide. The load back rest shall be no wider than that of the base arms open end clearance.

Electrical System:

Manufacturer's standard battery and charger. Charger shall be install at time of Delivery. Battery storage system shall include any available standard or optional Features to allow for easy removal and replacement.

The bidder is responsible for any or all electrical requirements to properly install
The type of battery charger offered by bidder.

Operator's Station:

Standard stand up type, forward facing\stance. Standard operator controls and overhead guard. Conforms to all current industry standards. To include all manufacture's standard features as stated in brochure.

Forks: 42 inches long minimum\48 inches long maximum

Steering: Electric\Power, with manufacturer's standard fixed or adjustable steering control position.

The reach truck shall be able to pass through access doorways with openings of 10 ft. high x 8 ft. wide or greater.

Any applicable safety and anti-vandalism options as stated in the manufacturer's Brochure shall be provided.

Safety Equipment:

Equipment shall meet all applicable OSHA regulations. All safety, instruction, and warning labels shall be in English.

Additional options:

Backup alarm and electric horn.

Strobe, amber beacon light (Flush mounted or magnetic on top of overhead guard.

Counter weights: Manufacturer's recommended amount if required.

Standard work lights to include rear work lights.

Lift and Tilt locking control valve.
