## PROCUREMENT POLICY OFFICE

### RESOLUTION 2019-001

**WHEREAS**, Guam Procurement Law centralizes all rights, powers, duties, and authority relating to the procurement of supplies, services, and construction, and the management, control, warehousing of supplies, services, and construction vested in, or exercised by, any governmental body to the Procurement Policy Office and the Chief Procurement Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, the Procurement Policy Office has the authority and responsibility to promulgate regulations governing the procurement, management, control and disposal of any and all supplies, services, and construction to be procured by the Territory of Guam; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Procurement Officer must procure or supervise the procurement of all supplies and services needed by the Territory of Guam in accordance with regulations promulgated by the Procurement Policy Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Procurement Officer, subject to the regulations of the Procurement Policy Office, may delegate authority to designees or to any governmental body or official; and

**WHEREAS**, the Port Authority of Guam has requested that authority be delegated to it to procure for itself; and

**WHEREAS**, the Procurement Policy Office and the Chief Procurement Officer have determined that the Port Authority of Guam possesses the expertise of procurement knowledge; and

**WHEREAS**, the Port Authority of Guam has demonstrated that it has corrected problems identified when it was previously delegated procurement authority; and

**WHEREAS**, an exceptional degree of economy and efficiency would be achieved in meeting the island's requirements if authority is delegated; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Chief Procurement Officer does not possess the necessary available resources to economically and efficiently procure for the Port Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, delegating procurement authority to the Port Authority is consistent with the Chief Procurement Officer and Procurement Policy Office's decision to delegate under other similar circumstances.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED THAT:**

1. Effective August 01, 2019, full procurement authority will be hereby delegated to the Port Authority of Guam.
2. The Port Authority of Guam shall have the assistance of the General Services Agency to enable a smooth transition.
3. Port Authority of Guam may continue to use Tenda Gubetnu for continued supply of items covered in inventory.
4. The Procurement Policy Office will require the Port Authority of Guam to report by January 31, 2020 that it has, since August 01, 2019 complied in all material aspects with procurement laws and regulations as set forth in 5GCA Chapter 5, 2GAR, Division 4 and decisions of the Procurement Policy Office as published from time to time.

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
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
