



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL ERA TENANTS

The Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) Program is subject to availability of funds. Eligible tenants will be assisted until funds are exhausted, or you have reached your maximum assistance upon which you will be responsible for all rental and utilities payments once the benefit ends. We strongly encourage you to take the steps necessary to sustain your household by your own means. If you are at risk for eviction or cannot afford the current rental amount, please utilize this time to search for housing that you will be able to afford on your own.

For additional support you can contact the Office of Homelessness Assistance and Poverty Prevention (OHAPP) and they can evaluate your circumstances and determine if any services are available to assist you. This includes:

- referrals to the Department of Labor for employment assistance
- verifying if you are eligible for SNAP and Medicaid
- referrals to shelter programs with the Guam Homeless Coalition
- Assist with GHURA application for public housing
